Public Notice of Teacher Quality [Highly Qualified]

The No Child Left Behind Act [NCLB] of 2001 requires each Local Education Agency [LEA] to publicly report progress of the LEA and its campuses toward meeting highly qualified teacher requirements.

The following standards are required to be considered a Highly Qualified teacher:

- Has obtained a Texas teacher certification
- Holds a minimum of a Bachelor's Degree
- Demonstrates subject matter competency in each of the academic subjects taught
- Competency is obtained by passing the Texas content exam and/or completing 24 college hours in the subject being taught (with 12 of those hours being upper level courses)
